

3. Falls June 7<sup>th</sup> 1947

The Council members of the Municipality of the Township of Ross met in the Council chambers at Foresters Falls on June 7<sup>th</sup> 1947 at 10.A.M. as a Court of Revision. All members subscribed to the oath of the Court. Moved by Mr Ross sec by Mr Bennett that Mr Wallace ~~be~~ elected Chairman, Council. There were four appeals against <sup>property</sup> assessment, and two notices against dog assessments. In the case of Mrs Elizabeth Gurry the assessment on buildings was reduced \$40.<sup>00</sup> Assessments of Lorenza Edmonds and Miss Anna Brown were sustained. A refund of 1946 taxes asked for by Charles Waite was ~~not~~ granted. A return of \$2.00 on dog tax to Thomas Moyam was granted, and an assessment of a dog under the name of C. B. Bulmer was taken from the Roll. The assessment Roll of 1946 was accepted as the assessment Roll for 1947.

Upon motion of Mr Byce sec by Mr Childhouse the Court of Revision was then adjourned.
