

June 5th 1948

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr. W. G. Gibson municipal engineer attended the meeting and discussed with Council the advisability of renting road building machinery this year for the improvement of certain roads. This the Council decided to do Mr. Gibson being instructed to procure said machines.

The North Keefew Agriculture Society having asked for a grant it was moved by Ira Byce seconded by Ruben Oattes that this grant be the sum of \$50.00.

Having received notice from Mr. Alan McDonald that owing to ill health he would ~~not~~ be unable to perform the duties of Assessor this year it was moved by Wm Ferguson seconded by Joe Bennett that we advertise for the filling of this office moved by Ruben Oattes seconded by Ira Byce that this Council set a price for whitewashing private property at \$3.00 per hour plus lime and disinfectant with a minimum charge of \$5.00 on motion of Joe Bennett seconded by Wm Ferguson the price for spraying weeds be \$3.00 per hour plus price of chemical with a minimum charge of \$5.00.

The Clerk was instructed by Council to order a spray gun and four nozzle spray broom.

A By-Law was enacted on motion of Ira Byce seconded by Ruben Oattes for the purpose of petitioning the Hydro Electric Power Commission to install four additional lights on the streets of Forsters Falls.
