By Law # 604 was introduced by Mr Bennett and Mr Gould to authorize the Revere and Ingram to borrow a sum of money not to exceed 20000 On motion of Mr Catter seconded by Mrs Gillan this By-law was given its second and third reading and passed.

It was the unanimous decision of the Council that we accept the tender of Stanley Black. and the Clerk was to notify him to attend the next Council Meeting

Moved by J. Gould Sec. by R. Catter that we pay balance of school money at this meeting.
