Moved by Jos Bennett seconded by Jos Gould that we the members of the Ross Township Council go on record as being opposed to the proposed change in the Public Library Act and that the clerk notify our member Mr Stanley Hunt of our protest.

Mr Stanley Black discussed with Council the position of Township assessor and upon motion of Mr. Gillan and R. Dater Mr Black was engaged as assessor for 1949 at a salary of \$700.⁰⁰

After considerable discussion regarding the width of road and absence of shouldering to the road in the west end of the village of Foresters Falls it was moved by R Dater seconded by Mr. Gillan that we petition the County good Road Committee to take action at an early date to rectify the dangerous conditions of this street.
