Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Mr Graham Patterson attended Council in regard to a Contract for snowploughing for 1949-1950 This was discussed and Mr Jas Bennett was appointed to represent the Council in a further interview with Mr Patterson. Mr McCormie and Mr Bulger discussed with Council the spraying of weeds and brush and recommended the purchase of C.I.L. products for this purpose.

Masses Gilmore and Rose presented a petition and discussed with Council the cleaning and deepening of road ditches in the Village of Halys and also need of a public dump. On motion of R. Dattis and N. Gillan a Committee was appointed consisting of Mr Childerhouse and Mr Gould to make an investigation and report to next meeting of Council.

Moved by Mr Bennett second Mr Gould that when the Township power grader is ^{employed} other than on Township roads the rate be set at \$6.00 per hour.

Moved by N. Gillan seconded by R. Dattis that we have the power grader insured.
