The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date with all members present.

Minutes of last meeting were read and adopted.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Harry Johnston interviewed Council regarding rolling or snow ploughing of this road. Decision was deferred until next meeting.

Ogal Ross made application to Council for a tile drainage loan.

Upon motion of Reuben Oattes and Norman Gillan By-Law no 605 was enacted for the purpose of borrowing money ^{from Provincial Treasurer of Ontario at interest of 3%} under the tile drainage act.

Under motion of Joe Bennett & Norman Gillan By-Law No 606 was passed for the purpose of purchasing lands which would ^{not bring} the amount of arrears of taxes, at the Land Tax Sale held year 1949.

Norman Gillan gave notice of the introduction of the By-Law for the purpose of levying rates for year 1949.

Upon his motion and by J. J. Gould By-law no 607 was given its first reading.

Upon motion of Joe Bennett & Reuben Oattes by-law 607 was given its 2nd reading and had rates filled in as follows. -
