The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M. All members being present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read adopted and signed by the Clerk. Communications were read and considered.

Rev. P.^S Dwin of Beachburg interviewed Council regarding the care of Mrs. Parkinson.

A Bylaw was introduced by Joseph Bennett to make compulsory the spraying of Cattle for Warble Fly within the Township and on his motion seconded by J. J. Gould the Bylaw was given its first reading.

Upon motion of R. Dattis and W. Pettigrew Bylaw No 612 was given its second & third reading and passed.

Moved by R. Dattis seconded by J. Bennett that the Council assume responsibility of an indigent patient now in an Ottawa Institution in the event of their being returned to the municipality.
