Minutes of previous meeting were read adopted and signed by the Reeve. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Upon motion of Wm Pettigrew and Joseph Bennett Stewart Childhouse was appointed to represent the Township of Ross on the Board of Directors of Childrens Aid Society of Kuperus Ontario.

It being necessary to pass a By Law for the purpose of appointing an inspector in connection with spraying of Cattle for Warble Fly. It was moved by Ruben Cattes and seconded by Wm Pettigrew that Russell Jose Ewen be given this appointment, carried. Moved by Joe Bennett seconded by John Gould that Allan Cole be appointed to attend the Dominion Machinery Service School held at Goderich on April 4th 5th and 6th.

Special Meeting of Ross Township Council met at R. A. Fraser Cobden on evening of April 25th 1950. Members present Reene Childerhose and Councillors Lattes and Gould.

Purpose of meeting was to appoint an Inspector in connection with spraying of Cattle for Warble Fly. Mr Ed Hill was present regarding this appointment upon motion of R. Lattes & J. Gould John Pettigrew of Jonestown Falls was appointed inspector at 50¢ per hour. It being deemed necessary to appoint an additional helper for the spraying of Cattle it was moved by R. Lattes seconded by J. Gould that Ed Hill be employed at a wage rate of 60¢ per hour plus 5¢ per mile for use of Car.

The Dominion Magnesium Co Ltd having proposed that they could spread crushed rock and slag on Township roads at a price of 25¢ per truck load it was moved by Reuben Lattes seconded by J. Gould that we accept this offer and have some Township roads near mine surfaced.
