 sum of \$18.00 for the care of Miss Ruth Parkinson  
 at the Bronson Memorial Home Ottawa

 W. Pettigrew was paid the sum of \$16.00 for  
 cleaning of dump.

 that R. Lattis and J. Bennett be a Committee  
 for the purpose of repairing side walks in  
 Foresters Falls

Council adjourned for one hour for the purpose  
 of inspecting Grants Settlement Road.

 for tenderst for the crushing and spreading  
 on Township roads 4000 or more yards  
 of Gravel
