The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on the above date with Reeve Childerhose & Councillors - Bennett, Oattes, Gould & Pettigrew present. Minutes of previous meeting were read and signed by Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Erwin Patterson discussed with Council the snow plowing of Township Roads for the winter of 1950-51.

Ira Byce discussed the renting of a bull doger to do some work on Grant Settlement road.

Stanley Black was present and reported progress being made with the Township Assessment.

Moved by Jos Bennett seconded by J.J. Gould that Stanley Black be given the salary for 200 for making the Assessment.

Moved by W.M. Pettigrew seconded by J.J. Gould that the township mill rate be increased by $\frac{1}{2}$ mill.

Application for loan under tile Drainage Act was received from Kenneth Eckford.

Moved by P. Oattes seconded by W. Pettigrew that North Renfrew Agr. Society receive a grant of \$50.00.

A By-Law was enacted upon motion of J. Bennett & R. Oattes to accept the mill rates for the year 1950, as presented by the clerk.

Special Meeting Aug 14

A special meeting met at the home
 of R. A. Fraser on 14th Aug¹⁹⁵⁰ for the
 purpose of passing a by-law to
 stop up and close a portion of
 Kerr line which will be flooded
 with water due to Hydro. Development
 at Cheneau Falls; and to transfer
 same to Hydro Electric Power
 Commission of Ontario; and to
 accept a re-located road built
 by the Hydro Electric Commission of
 Ont. according to specifications
 drawn up by the Hydro Commission
 and accepted by Township Council.

Owing to dissatisfaction in the purchasing of land
 for the relocated road on Kerr line it was necessary
 for the Township Council to meet with Hydro Electric
 Power Commission officials at their Cheneau development
 office for the purpose of re-riving a portion of
 the proposed road. After a careful study of the
 situation had been made a new location for
 the road was deemed satisfactory and accepted
 by the Council. A new map of the road was
 prepared and signed by the Rees and Clerk
 on August 19th 1950. Council members present at
 meeting were Kerr Childersha Councillors R. Oattes
