

Foresters Falls September 6th 1950

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 7.30 P.M.
members present were Childhouse Councillors Bennett, Lattis and Gould.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted.

Communications were read and considered. Councillor Melville Eady of Horton Township discussed with the Council the maintenance of townline roads between Horton and Ross Townships. An agreement was to be drawn up whereby Ross Township was to do the work and Horton Township would pay 50% of the expenses.

Mr John Ross appeared before Council asking permission to put in a cattle pass at his property Lots 9-10 - Concession 1. This was granted.

A delegation of ratepayers from the Haley section of the Township were present to discuss with Council the forming of the Kenfruw and Cobden High School areas.

Upon motion of J. Gould and R. Lattis Miller Bros were engaged to do surplus snowploughing on Township roads for the season of 1950 and 51. Moved by J. Bennett second by J. Gould that the Township be the purchaser of all Township properties not bringing the amount of arrears of taxes at the land sale in 1950.

Moved by J. Bennett second by J. Gould that our road Superintendent repairs townline between Ross and Horton Townships Horton to pay half the expenses and that this motion take effect when approved by Horton Council.

Moved by R. Lattis second by J. Gould that the Township contribute to the cost of supplying free insulin for an old age Pensioner.

Clerk was instructed to notify H. A. Gornie Municipal Engineer that we had failed to receive replies to our tenders for crushing and spreading gravel on Township roads but could have the work done by B. Gundt of Stratford for \$1.00 per yard Council to pay for gravel.

Upon reassembling minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted.

Communications were read and considered. Upon motion of Joe Bennett and Mrs Gould permission was granted J. M. Ross to build a cattle pass between Lots 9-10 Concession 1 same to be built and maintained by Mr Ross, and to comply to plans and supervision of the Road Superintendent.

Moved by Wm Pettigrew seconded by Mrs Gould that we instruct the Clerk to apply to the Compensation Board for information regarding coverage for sewer employees.

Moved by Joe Bennett seconded by Mrs Gould that this Council adopt the resolution as outlined by D. A. Gorie in regard to gravel crushing.
