

Foresters Falls Feb. 3rd 1951

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date at 10 A.M. with all members present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Upon motion of Ruben Oattes and Joseph Bennett the council approved of the employment of an architect ^{to draw up} plans and estimate cost of required accommodation to Cobden High School moved by Harvey Pilgrim seconded by Joe Bennett that we pay post sanatorium care to Wilfred Jack the sum of 20⁰⁰ per month retroactive to January 1st 1951.

Moved by J. Bennett sec by J. J. Gould that dog tax be refunded to Lawrence Cole.

Mr. John Brown appeared in council to discuss the possibility of Council opening a road to his bush lot. No action was taken.

Mr. Harry Johnston and Hubert Miller discussed with Council the snowploughing of road leading to the Johnston home. It was decided not to make any further attempt to plough over the large hills on this road.

Mr. Chester Danlieu appeared before Council asking for financial assistance till he could procure work. He was given a letter from Council to present to the employment Bureau Request asking that they give him special consideration in the securing of employment.

Mrs. Fred Ross and Duoin Patterson discussed with Council problems pertaining to Cobden and District High School.

621 A By Law was introduced by Messrs H. Pilgrim and R Oattes prohibiting buildings being erected on private property within the required number of feet of said road running from Hales to Postage dw - Fort. This By Law was given its first and second reading.

Moved by H. Pilgrim seconded by R Oattes that we renew our membership to the municipal association.

Moved by J. J. Gould seconded by J. Bennett that we request the Department of Highways to approve of our 1951 Road improvement By Law for the amount of \$25000.00

Moved by J. J. Gould seconded by R. Datto that the Council take no action in regard to assisting in fire protection within the Township.
