

Foresters Falls March 23/51

A special meeting of Ross Township Council was held on the evening of above date at F. Falls with all members present.

Down applications were received for the filling of position of Grader and sprayer operator. After each application had been reviewed by Council it was moved by Harvey Pilgrim seconded by J. J. Gould that we engage George Code for year 1951.

Moved by R. Qattes seconded by H. Pilgrim that the motion of January meeting pertaining to scale of wages for township employes be rescinded.

Moved by R. Qattes seconded by H. Pilgrim that the following scale of wages be effective for the year 1951. Road Superintendent \$1.00 per hour. Grader operator 85¢ Sprayer operator 85¢ Patrolman 75¢ Laborer 70¢ Man and Team 1.05 Team and Mower 2.25 Tractor and Mower 2.25 Tractor for Grading 2.00

1 Ton Truck 1.45 2 Ton Truck 1.70 3 Ton Truck 2.20

Upon motion of J. Bennett and R. Qattes the Clerk was instructed to procure necessary powder for cattle spraying.

A petition was presented to Council signed by the Chairmen <sup>school boards</sup> of school sections numbers 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13. Petitioning that all school sections in the Township of Ross remain included in the Cobden and district High School area.

The Council discussed the High School question at some length and resulted in a motion being proposed by H. Pilgrim seconded by J. Gould that we detach High School sections numbers 3, 4 and 5 from Cobden High School area and attach said sections to Kennewick school area. This motion was defeated.

Moved by R. Qattes seconded by J. Bennett that we put the question of Ross Township going into High School area at Cobden to a vote of the electors of the township. This motion was declared passed.

A By-law was introduced by J. Bennett seconded by R. Qattes that the date for taking the vote on the High School question be April 20th/1951 and that the polls be from between the hours of 9 A.M. to 6 P.M. and that the following officers be appointed to be in attendance at the different Polls

Whereas the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross have been requested by the majority of the Public School Boards in the above mentioned Township to approve the action of the Cobden and District High School Board to proceed with the tentative plans and specifications for the building of an addition to the Cobden and District High School Building and with the issuing of twenty year debentures to cover an estimated cost of \$174300.00.

In the event of school sections numbers three four and five being detached from Cobden and District High School area that they would be exempt from payments on debentures in Cobden and District High School area.

Assessment of school sections numbers three, four and five is approximately \$250000.00.
