All Members present. Revere Childerhose Councillors. Bennett, Datto and Pilgrim Minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by R. Datto seconded by J. Bennett that the Township become the Purchaser of Juf launds which do not bring the amount of tax arrears at the land sale of 1951

Upon motion of J. Bennett and H. Pilgrim a By-Law was enacted to extend the time of returning the assessment Roll of 1951 thirty days. This By Law was given first & second readings

Moved by R. Datto seconded by H. Pilgrim that we make application to the department of Highways to transfer the sum of \$500 from the maintenance to the Construction items in Road By-Law # 621

Upon motion of R. Datto and H. Pilgrim the August Road Voucher amounting to 3860.61 was accepted.
