

Fifty-seven appeals against assessment were heard at Admaston Township Court of Revision which lasted two days. Two appeals were withdrawn, five changes of ownership were recorded, one omission was added, one property was raised, 25 assessments were sustained and 24 were reduced by \$4,275 in total. Individual reductions were from \$15 to \$500. Local assessment is now \$1,082,218.
