 increasing our borrowing powers for Township
 expenditures from Twenty Thousand Dollars to a
 limit of Thirty Thousand Dollars.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by J. Gould that
 the Road Voucher for May 1952 for the amount
 of 5,102.37 be accepted.
