Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by H. Pilgrim seconded by J. Bennett that we give a grant of 50.00 to the North Renfrew Agricultural Society and a grant of 100.00 to the Cobden Agricultural Society.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by J. Gould that we pay to Renfrew County pro-rates for general and road rates of the money expected from Ottawa in lieu of taxes on Light Alleys to aid in construction of road from Magnesium Mine to connect with Halys and Portage Road on completion of the expenditure appropriated by County for said road of \$24,000.00.

Moved by H. Pilgrim seconded by J. Gould that we accept and pay Road Voucher # 7 for July for the amount of \$726.97
