Moved by R. Cattie seconded by H. Pilgrim that we pass By-Law (1st reading) approving expenditure of money under drainage act for drainage on Leslie Collins' farm.

Moved by R. Cattie seconded by H. Pilgrim that we apply to Minister of Highways for the transfer of \$300.00 from Maintenance account to the Culverts & Bridges account in our road money By-Law.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by R. Cattie that the Court of Revision be held on Tuesday, November the 18th 1952.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by J. Gould that the Road Voucher for Sept. for the amount of \$4561.73 be accepted.
