Moved by J. Bennett seconded by St. Pilgrim that we appoint Mr. Irwin Patterson as Trustee for Colden & District High School Board for 1953.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by J. Gould that we apply to The Hydro Electric Commission to have an electric installed opposite Archie Waiter's house.

Moved by R. Oatley seconded by N. Pilgrim that we request County Council to erect 30 M.P.H. signs East and West of Dominion Magnesium Mines property and Light Alloys; also the request for safety signals at Haley at what is known as Lowin's Crossing on The C.P. Railway and a stop sign erected at intersection of County & Township road at Archie Hawthorn's corner.

Moved by J. Gould seconded by R. Oatley that we request the Ont. Dept. of Highways to have 30 M.P.H. signs erected North & South of Haley on Highway 17.

Moved by N. Pilgrim seconded by R. Oatley that we refund \$50.00 to L.O.L. #552 for use of Orange Hall for Township purposes to a maximum of five meetings.

Moved by R. Oatley seconded by St. Pilgrim that the Township pay the sum of \$1,373.50 to the Highways Account.

Moved by J. Gould seconded by J. Bennett that an advertisement be put in The Colden Sun requesting all parties to refrain from parking their cars on the side of snowploughed roads in the Township as they would be held liable for the cost of removing them.
