Said by-law places restrictions on buildings along County road # 4 in Pass Township. Said road passes through or abuts part of Lot 23 in 2nd Con. Lot 23 in 3rd Con., Lots 23, 24, 25 in Con. 4, Lots 25 + 26 in Con. 5, Lots 26 + 27 in Con. 6, Lot 27 in Con. 7 including boundary line between Township of Pass and Township of ~~Dorset~~ Horton.
