Moved by J. Bennett seconded by H. Pilgrim that we employ Mr. Leonard A. Doysee to resurvey the old award ditch and advise regarding it.

August 1st (Continued)

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by J. Gould that we pay the annual grant of \$50.00 to the North Renfrew Agricultural Society and \$100.00 grant to the Colden Agricultural Society.

Moved by H. Pilgrim seconded by R. Cattie that we have road from Fourth Line corner to Cadys corner primed and mulched a distance of approximately $1\frac{3}{4}$ miles and also the street at Halcyon from County road to C. P. R. Station via Howards Store a distance of approximately 700 ft. Work to be done while County job on Postage road is in progress at the same rate as County road.

Moved by R. Cattie seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept Road Voucher # 7 for the month of July for the amount of \$1,125.91.
