

Forsters Falls, Ont. Feb. 6th. 1954

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted. Communications & accounts were read and considered.

On a request by Selmar Bennett chairman of No. 1 School Area it was moved by Wm. Stone seconded by J. Bennett that tentative approval be given to School Board of No. 1 School Area ~~to~~ to raise the necessary funds to rebuild a one room, one storey school on old school site at Forsters Falls at an estimated cost of \$20,000.00.

On a request by John New chairman of No. 2 School Area it was moved by R. Oatley seconded by St. Pilgrim that tentative approval be given to School Board of No. 2 School Area to raise the necessary funds to build a new four room school in the Haley vicinity, site to be decided on. Estimated cost \$80,000.00.

Moved by Wm. Stone seconded by J. Bennett that the Clerk contact several Companies with regard to information on makes, sizes & prices of fire fighting equipment.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by R. Oatley that we accept and pay Road Voucher #1 for the Month of January 1954 for the amount of \$2,745.74.

Under by-law # 646 the following accounts were passed for payment and orders drawn on the Treasurer for same:-
