

Township Falls, Ont. March 6<sup>th</sup> 1954

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with Reeve Childerhose and Councillors Pilgrim, Bennett and Stone present.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and communications and accounts were read and considered.

Upon a Resolution being presented by Ross Township School Area #1, it was moved by J. Bennett seconded by Wm. Stone that we pass tentative by-law authorizing School Area #1. to borrow by Debentures the sum of \$20,000.00 for the purpose of erecting and equipping a one story, one room school to replace the one destroyed by fire.

Upon a Resolution being presented by Ross Township School Area #2 it was moved by N. Pilgrim seconded by J. Bennett that we pass tentative by-law authorizing School Area #2 to borrow by Debentures the sum of \$80,000.00 for the purpose of erecting and equipping a new one story, four room public school.

Moved by N. Pilgrim seconded by Wm. Stone that we pass by-law #659 to amend by-laws 621 and 644.

Moved by N. Pilgrim seconded by J. Bennett that we pass by-law to set the wages for Warble Fly Spray Operator and Inspector for the year 1954 at \$9.00 per hr.

Moved by Wm. Stone seconded by J. Bennett that the Clerk contact the Fire Marshall at Toronto and request him to send a representative to our Municipality as soon as possible to give us information on the line of fire fighting equipment most suitable for our Township.

Moved by Wm. Stone seconded by N. Pilgrim that we accept the offer of \$40,000 from Gordon Gibbons as payment in full for road allowance which crosses his property, caused by construction of new County Road, if there are no other legal claims by any of the parties affected.

Moved by Wm. Stone seconded by N. Pilgrim that this Council go on record requesting the Dept. of Highways for a Development Road from Portage Du Fort to Westmeath boundary.

Moved by J. Bennett seconded by N. Pilgrim that we call for tenders for the crushing, hauling and spreading of 4000 yds. of gravel for Township Roads for 1954.

Moved by H. Pilgrim seconded by J. Bennett that we accept and pay Road Voucher for the month of February for the amount of \$1,714.01
