Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by J. Bennett that Council pass by-law for the purpose of the establishment and maintenance of a Reserve Fund for the sum of \$3,720.35.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by R. Catts that Council give approval to the passing of a by-law for the purpose of giving the Revere and Treasurer authority to borrow ^{to} the amount of \$60,000.00 if necessary, to finance the building of schools in No. 1 and No. 2 School Areas, pending the sale of debentures totaling the sum of \$92,300.00. Amount borrowed by the School Areas to be paid back to the Township when the debentures are sold.
