

Foresters Falls, Ont. May 7th 1955

The Municipal Council of the Township of Pass met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and signed.

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead seconded by Wm. Stone that we re-engage Mr. C. R. Simpson C. A. as auditor for the Township for the current year.

Upon a request being made by the Clerk to have unemployment insurance discontinued it was moved by Wm. Stone seconded by R. Oattes that we make application to Unemployment Insurance Commission to have it discontinued.

Moved by W. Stone seconded by G. Olmstead that Council accept the tender of Smith's Construction Co. of Ampnes for crushing, hauling & spreading of 4000 yds more or less of gravel for Township roads for 1955 at the rate of \$1.16 per yd. stockpiling <sup>per 400</sup> 72.

A petition signed by about 85 per cent of the cattle owners in the Township was presented to the Council requesting them to pass a by-law to innoculate heifer calves against the disease of Brucellosis in Pass Township in accordance with the Brucellosis Control Act. For the above purpose it was moved by W. Stone, seconded by R. Oattes that we give first reading to a by-law for the prevention of Brucellosis in accordance with the Brucellosis Control Act.

Moved by R. Oattes, seconded by W. Stone that we accept & pay Road Voucher #4 for the Month of April for \$2615.89

Under By-law # 677 the following accounts were <sup>(paid)</sup> passed for W. Waite, shovelling snow from fire hall \$6.80, A. N. Coighlin, Warble fly Inspector \$123.80, S. J. Childhouse, Warble fly \$546.00, Allan F. Pass, Ins on fire truck and Road liability \$202.66, N. L. Ross, supplies \$22. Municipal World, Ltd. supplies \$182.2, G. L. Howard, Relief for Re. Alex Boves for <sup>April</sup> ~~May~~ \$60.00, Henry Robe, fox hourly \$3.00, Colden Post Office, Unemp Ins. Stamps 639.
