Moved by G. Olmstead, seconded by R. Cattie that N. Pilgrim engage contractor to build cistern at Halys and accommodation for small pump for fire protection.

Moved by N. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Olmstead that we accept and pay Road Voucher #6 for the Month of June for the amount of \$2,168.47.
