

Foresters Falls. Oct. 2nd 1955

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve

Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by G. Almstead that we rescind former by-law #647 re Municipal employees and pass by-law No 683 to make new wage scale as follows:- Road Superintendent unchanged 1.10 per hr., Loader Operator, unchanged 1.00 per hr., Labourers ~~95¢ per hr.~~ raised to .95 ¢ per hr.

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we pass by-law for the purpose of setting date of Nomination of candidates for Township Council and for Trustees for School Areas No 1 & No 2 in the Township of Ross for Monday November 21st 1955, and the date of election if necessary one week later Monday November 28th 1955.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council make application to the Dept. of Municipal Affairs for an extension of 30 days for the return of the Assessment Roll

Moved by G. Almstead seconded by H. Pilgrim that we donate the sum of \$100.00 to Colden Agricultural Society and \$50.00 to North Renfrew Agricultural Society

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 8 for the Month of August for the amount of \$3657.18.

Under by-law No. 677 the following accounts were passed for payment. Donald Scobie, cutting weeds \$3.00, Pettigrew's Garage, light bulbs \$8.25, Pettigrew's Garage, gas & oil for fire engine \$11.00, J. C. Murdoch, sidewalk in F. Falls \$125.00, Colden Agr. Society, grant \$100.00, H. L. Ross, part salary \$250.00, Donald Hubert, fox bounty 3.00, Lorne Kohlsmith, fox bounty 3.00, Samuel Rankin, fox bounty \$3.00, Jack Ferguson fox bounty \$3.00, Joseph Linnin, fox bounty \$6.00, Colden Post Office, Unemp. Ins. Stamps \$6.00
