In the absence of the Reeve it was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Almstead that R. Catter act as Reeve pro tem for this meeting.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we pass a by-law for the purpose of setting date of Nominations of Candidates for Township Council and for Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and No. 2 in the Township of Ross for Monday, November 26th 1956 and the date of election, if necessary, one week later Monday December 3rd 1956.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead that we pass a by-law for the purpose of appointing Officers in the event an election would be necessary, for Reeve, Councillors and Public School Board Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and No. 2 for the year 1957 and have the blanks filled in as follows:-

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we rescind by-law No. 695 re Municipal Employees wages to be replaced by by-law No. 703 to make new wage scale as follows:-
 Road Superintendent unchanged \$1.15 per hour, Grader Operator unchanged \$1.10 per hour, Labourers raised from .954 per hour to \$1.05 per hour.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 9 for the Month of September for the amount of \$890.00.
