Faustus Falls, Ont. Nov. 24th 1956

Special meeting called on above to consider drainage & road matters.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we pass a resolution petitioning the Dept. of Highways for sufficient funds through a development grant to complete the grade of Development road No. M.D. 54-99, Development Road No. 258 Mun. Dist. No. 10 R/F/Hy Div. No. 10 which would now be the section beginning at Millon's corner on the Kerr Line through the Kerr line to the corner known as Olmstead's corner, then southerly on road leading from Olmstead's corner to road known as Queens Line instead of continuing balance of Kerr Line road to Ross-Horton boundary.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Oattes that Council give first reading to by-law no. 705 to apply for grant under the Municipal Drainage Act for the purpose of digging and deepening ditch in the Townships between lots N $\frac{1}{2}$ & S $\frac{1}{2}$ 9 Con. 6 thence through the corner of Lot S $\frac{1}{2}$ 9 to County road between Cons. 6 & 7.
