Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council make agreement with Millar Bros to do the surplus snow ploughing for the years 1957-58, through a contract based on the same wages and guarantee as for season 1956-57.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council give a grant of \$50.00 to the Ross Cemetery Committee towards upkeep owing to new Board of Health regulations.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we appoint Reuben Catts as a member to the Civil Defence Committee for Ross area.

Mrs. Reuben Catts introduced a by-law to appoint a Trench Excavator Inspector for the Township, and under his motion, seconded by Geo.
