Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and communications and accounts were read and considered.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we request the Dept. of Highways to transfer the amount of \$8,000.00 from New Machinery to Road Construction on 1956 Road Appropriation by-law No. 693.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council make agreement with Millar Bros to do the surplus snow ploughing for the years 1957-58, through a contract based on the same wages and guarantee as for season 1956-57.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council give a grant of \$50.00 to the Ross Cemetery Committee towards upkeep owing to new Board of Health regulations.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we appoint Reuben Catts as a member to the Civil Defence Committee for Ross area.

Mrs. Reuben Catts introduced a by-law to appoint a Trench Excavator Inspector for the Township, and under his motion, seconded by Geo. Olmstead, the above by-law appointing Mr. Harvey Pilgrim as Trench Excavator Inspector for the year 1957 was given three readings and passed this 5th day of March 1957.
