

Forsters Falls, Ont. Sept. 3d 1957.

The regular monthly meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

The minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and accounts and communications were read and ~~adopted~~ considered.

A motion was moved by Wm. Stone and seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council proclaim one legal school holiday in the Township for Fall fair.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we give a grant of \$50.00 to the Cobden Cemetery Committee for upkeep of cemetery.

The Consumers Gas Co. of Toronto made application to the Township of Ross requesting that we authorize them a franchise to construct a gas pipe line through the Township. For this purpose a by-law was introduced by Wm. Stone and seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we give first and second reading to a by-law authorizing them to construct above pipe line.

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we request Ontario Fuel Board to make an order to dispense with a vote of electors of the Township of Ross in respect to by-law between Ross Township and the Consumers Gas Co.

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by G. Olmstead that we accept the tender of A. H. Mc Coy Construction Co. of Stittsville for proposed grading of Kerr Line including base, crushed gravel and rock excavation at a price of \$26,750.00 subject to the approval of the Dept. of Highways.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 8 for the month of August 1957 for the amount of \$1,056.97.

Under by-law No. 709 the following accounts were passed for payment: Ernest Foss, sheep killed by dogs \$23.00, Joseph Bennett, sheep killed by dogs \$115.00, Wm. McLaughlin, sheep killed by dogs \$15.00, Robt. S. Pettigrew, work at spraying \$9.60, Pettigrew's Garage, Gas & repair for fire truck \$16.75, Pettigrew's Garage, street lights \$2.04, Wilfred Waite, installing light bulbs 1.00, H. L. Ross, phone messages \$4.95, Peter Brown, relief \$20.00, Cobden Cemetery Committee, Grant 50.00, J. C. Murdoch, fox bounty \$3.00, Ray Bennett, fox bounty \$3.00.

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we apply to the Dept. of Municipal Affairs for 30 days extension for return of Assessment Roll and pass by-law for same.
