

Forsters Falls, Ont. April 2nd. 1958

The Auditor's Report was presented and showed a substantial surplus on the year's business.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by N. Pilgrim that Council accept Roy Patterson's tender for White Fly powder at the price of \$20.90 per 50 lbs. per bag delivered to Township garage.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by N. Pilgrim that we call for tenders for 7000 tons of crushed gravel to pass through a $\frac{5}{8}$ inch mesh to be delivered and spread on Township roads and also for stockpiling.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by N. Pilgrim that Council call for tenders for necessary culverts required by the Township for 1958.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Almstead that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 3 for the month of March 1958 for the amount of \$1,909.74.
