

Foresters Falls, Ont. May 7th 1958

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and signed by the Reens and communications and accounts were read and discussed.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Cattie that we rescind by law No. 713 regarding wages of spraying Inspector and helpers and replaced by by-law No. 733 whereby the wages of spraying Inspector and helper be raised from \$1.10 to \$1.20 per hour.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Cattie that Council pay the Fire Chief and two volunteer fire fighters the amount of ten dollars per day to attend a fire fighters school for two days to be held in Renfrew during the week of June 2 to 6th.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by R. Cattie that we accept the tender of A. H. Mc Coy Construction Co Ltd. for the crushing and spreading of approximately 7,000 tons of gravel on Township roads at a price of .90¢ per ton and a price of 40¢ per ton for stockpiling.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Almstead that Council accept the tender of Ray Patterson to supply the required culverts for Township purposes for the year 1958.

Moved by R. Cattie, seconded by H. Pilgrim that under relief regulations we pay Mrs. Alice Wall relief to the amount of \$60.00 per month.

Moved by G. Almstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 4 for the month of April 1958 for the amount of \$2,571.57.
