The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with Reeve Stewart Childerhose and Councillors R. Oattes, Wm. Stone and Geo. Almstead present.

Minutes of former meetings were read and adopted. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Almstead that Council apply to the Dept. of Highways for interim subsidy payment on Township roads to August 31st 1958.

Moved by R. Oattes, ^{seconded by Geo. Almstead} that we give first & second reading to a by-law governing the rates for the Township for the year 1958 subject to the approval of the Dept. of Municipal Affairs.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by R. Oattes that we pass a by-law for the purpose of applying to the Dept. of Municipal Affairs for a quieting order to establish the proper area, boundaries, legal existence and corporate status of the Township of Ross.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Almstead that Council petition the Dept. of Highways for an additional Supplementary by-law for the amount of \$6000.00 to meet balance of road expenditures for the year 1958.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by R. Oattes that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 8 for the month of August 1958 for the amount of 7,860.65.

Under by-law No. 729 the following accounts were passed for payment: Coleman's Garage, gas for fire truck \$5.97, Pettigrew's Garage, light bulbs \$6.63, Wilfred Waite, Instal. light bulbs \$3.25, Municipal World, Ltd. \$23.38, K. Coleman, fire training school \$10.00, Clarence Bilson, fire training school \$5.00, Raymond Bell, fire training school \$5.00, Ray Luttburner, fire training school, etc. \$21.00, Douglas Broome, work at Haley with fire engine \$6.00, Mrs. Theresa Mayhew, relief \$60.00, Mrs. Alice Wall, relief \$60.00, Mrs. Robert Bedard, relief \$60.00, Peter Brown, relief \$20.00, Cobden Post Office, unemp. ins. stamps \$7.22.
