

Township Falls, Ont. October 1st 1958.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with Councillors Reuben Oatis, Hawey Pilgrim, Wm. Stone & Geo. Olmstead present.

In the absence of the Reeve it was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Mr. Reuben Oatis act as Reeve (pro tem) for this meeting.

Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted. Communications and accounts were read and considered.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we set the date of the Court of Revision for the purpose of hearing assessment appeals, if any, for the date of November 10th 1958 at the hour of 8.00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Township Falls.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by G. Olmstead that we give three readings to a by-law for the purpose of setting a date for the nominations of Candidates for Township Council and for Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and No. 2 in the Township of Ross and the date for the above-mentioned purpose be set for Monday November 24th 1958 between the hours of 1.00 P.M. to 2.00 P.M. and the date for election, if necessary one week later December 1st 1958.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of appointing Officers, in the event of an election being necessary, for Reeve, Councillors and Public School Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and No. 2 for the year 1959, and have the blanks filled in as follows:-
 Pole No. 1 - Dep. Returning Officer, Leslie Collins, Pole Clerk, Mansel Hill
 Pole No. 2 Returning Officer, N. L. Ross, Pole Clerk, Irwin Patterson.
 Pole No. 3. Dep. Returning Officer, Richard Gould Sr. Pole Clerk Mrs. A. G. Hodgins.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we pass a by-law for the purpose of increasing wages of Township employees, effective October 1st 1958 as follows:

Road Superintendent from \$1.30 per hr. to \$1.40 per hour.

Grader Operator from \$1.20 per hr. to \$1.30 per hour.

Assistant Operator from \$1.10 per hr. to \$1.20 per hour.

Labourers \$1.00 per hour.

Moved by G. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that this Council give tentative approval to the Golden & District School Board for the issuing of debentures for the amount of \$60,000.00 for the purpose of building three new class rooms and a laboratory to the existing school building.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that this Council give ^{tentative} approval to the raising of debentures for the purpose of building a new five room Public School as approved by the Dept. of Education or that we might be agreeable to whatever decision might be taken by the Cobden Council.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we give third reading to a by-law for the purpose of accepting the rates as approved by the Department of Municipal Affairs. The rates as approved by the Department and accepted by this Council are as follows:-
