The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meetings were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve.

Communications and accounts were read and discussed.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council pay Wm. Eype the sum of \$700.00 as salary for canvassing cattle owners for signatures to have this area considered a brucellosis free area.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council pay the Orange Lodge of Foster's Falls the sum of \$50.00 for use of the hall for meetings for the year 1958.

Moved by P. Oattes, seconded by H. Pilgrim that in view of an error in the assessment of the Galilee Bible Camp the hall on the grounds being classed as a place of worship it should be considered exempt as provided in the Assessment Act. All other buildings and land being taxable.

Mrs. Harvey Lowrey of Pakemham interviewed the Council in regard to the proposed pipe line of the Consumers Gas Company route through the Township of Ross. It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council accept the proposed route of the pipe line of the Consumers Gas Co. through the Township and that Mr. Allan Cole, Road Superintendent be appointed as consultant and adviser between the Council and the Consumers Gas Company at the time of construction of same.
