

Forsters Falls, Ont. September 12th 1959

A special meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on above date to discuss the final approval of debentures for Cobden Public School and also to discuss the transfer of certain funds on supplementary by-law to other roads. Members present were Revere S. Childhouse and Councillors Wm. Stone, Geo. Olmstead and R. Oattes.

It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council give final approval to the issuing of debentures for the amount of \$80,000.00 for the purpose of financing the erection of a new four room Public School in the Village of Cobden of which S.S. No. 10 Ross forms a part.

Moved by R. Oattes, seconded by Wm. Stone that we apply to the Dept. of Highways to have certain monies provided by by-law No 752 transferred as follows:-
 \$2,000.00 from Bridges & Culverts on Kerr Line to Road Construction on other roads, \$3,000.00 from Road Construction on Kerr Line to Road Construction on other roads. The money to be used ^{for financing} on the following roads:-

1. The road East of Muskat Lake in Con. 1 from lot 3 to the Townline between Ross & Westmeath Townships.
2. The road in Con. 3 from Lot 8 (Cobden & Forsters Falls Highway), easterly to Lot 11.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we offer McMillan Bros. the contract for the surplus snow-ploughing in the Township for the 1959-60 season at the same terms as the previous year, namely \$7.00 per acre, with a minimum price of \$700.00, and if not acceptable, tenders will be called for same.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council purchase a wreath for the Cobden & District Legion to be placed on the cenotaph at Cobden November 11th 1959 at a cost of \$10.00.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by St. Pilgrim that we set the date of the Court of Revision for the purpose of hearing assessment appeals, if any, for the date of November 4th 1959 at the hour of 7.30 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Forestus Falls.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we give three readings to a by-law for the purpose of setting a date for the nomination of Candidates for Township Council and for Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and No. 2 in the Township Pass and that we set the date for the above-mentioned purpose at November 30th 1959, between the hours of 1.00 and 2.00 P.M., and the date for an election, if necessary, one week later: December 7th 1959.

Moved by St. Pilgrim, seconded by George Olmstead that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of appointing Officers in the event of an election being necessary for Plev. Councillors and Public School Trustees for School Areas No. 1 and 2 for the year 1960 and have the blanks filled in as follows:—
 Pole No. 1 Dep. Returning Officer, Leslie Collins, Pole Clerk, Marnel Hill.
 Pole No. 2 Returning Officer, H. L. Ross, Pole Clerk, Irwin Patterson.
 Pole No. 3 Dep. Returning Officer, Fred. Elmore, Pole Clerk, Mrs. C.A. Hodgins.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 9 for the Month of September 1959 for the amount of \$8352.75.
