The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date after the Court of Revision with all members present.

The minutes of former meeting were read and considered and communications and accounts were read and discussed.

An application was received from Mr. Norman Gillan for debentures for tile drainage on his property for the amount of \$400.00 and it was moved by R. Catts, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept the above application, subject to the approval of the Provincial Treasurer and that we give first reading to a by-law to that effect.

Council made Millar Bros the same offer for snowploughing as the previous year for the 1959-60 season, namely \$7.00 per hr. with a minimum price of \$700.00. This offer was accepted by Millar Bros for the 1959-60 snowploughing season.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead that we appoint Mr. Edwin Foss as Deputy Returning Officer for Poll No. 3 to replace Mr. Fred Elmore who was formerly appointed and later informed us he could not accept it.

Moved by R. Catts, seconded by Geo. Almstead that we amend by-law for road workers wages to include in Road Superintendents salary a car mileage of 5 cents per mile for road purposes

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pelgrim that this Council petition the County Council that procedure be taken in regard to having proper signals erected at the railroad crossing on County road in the Village of Haly which has been the scene of several minor accidents and recently been the scene of two fatal accidents. This is an urgent appeal and this Council respectfully request it be given special attention.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 10 for the Month of October 1959 for the amount of \$3,533.75.
