Moved by R. Catter, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept the Road Appropriation by-law as suggested by the Dept. of Highways for the year 1960 for the amount of \$42,500.00, being \$15,000.00 for construction and \$27,500.00 for maintenance, subject to the approval of the Department of Highways.

Moved by R. Catter, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept the plan for the signals at the C.P.R. Crossing at Halys as presented by the Board of Transport Commissioners Inspector.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council authorize Mr. Ray Sittthumer, Fire Chief to purchase the necessary hose and equipment for fire trucks at Forsters Falls and Halys as suggested.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Catter that Council accept the application of Mr. Hugh S. McEinn of Cobden for fire insurance to cover the fire hall at Halys for the amount of \$3,000.00 for a three year period.

Moved by R. Catter, seconded by Wm. Stone that we make application to the Dept. of Highways for a supplementary by-law for the amount of Thirty Seven Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty Five ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars \$37,625.00 for construction of Township roads for 1960. Cancelled
