The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on above date with all members present.

Minutes of former meetings were read and adopted.

Correspondence and accounts were then read and discussed.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we make application to the Dept. of Highways for a Supplementary by-law for the amount of \$37,500.00 for road construction for 1960.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept the tender of S. J. Childhouse for the supplying and delivering of 35 fifteen pound bags of waricide at a price of \$218.75 for cattle spraying in 1960.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by P. Catter that Council call tenders for crushing hauling and spreading on Township roads 10,000 tons of gravel and work to be completed on or before July 1st. Also to call for prices on stockpiling. Work to be under the supervision of the Road Superintendent. All gravel to be crushed to pass through a $\frac{5}{8}$ in. screen and quality of gravel to have the approval of the Road Superintendent.

Moved by P. Catter, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we call for tenders on all sizes of culverts for the requirements of the Township for the year 1960. All tenders to be received on or before April 30th at 12:00 O'Clock noon.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of appointing Mr. Arthur Somerville as Washable City Inspector for the 1960 season at the rate of \$1.20 per hr.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that we accept and pay Road Voucher No. 3 for the month of March for the amount of \$1,217.85.

Ross, Bal. salary Collector \$47.00, Kenneth Fay, fuel oil for Haly Fire Hall Invoice No. 421.21 \$19.04, Village of Colden, Ross share law costs \$17.30, Hugh G. McEwin, Ins. Haly Fire Hall \$24.00, Olivia Giroux, fox bounty \$4.00, Norman Gillan Tile drain debit payment \$300.95, Town of Renfrew Relief re Robert Barr \$42.68, Mrs. Francis Warner, relief \$30.00, Colden Post Office, unemp. ins. stamps \$4.80.
