 for the work of doing the surplus snowploughing in the  
 Township for the 1960-61 season as follows:- The rate  
 per <sup>ton</sup> of the present unit to be \$7.00. A minimum of \$700.00  
 for the season, permission to sell and transfer this  
 agreement to a third party (this third party to meet  
 the approval of the Council).

 Pilgrim that Council donate the sum of \$50.00 to the  
 Cobden and District Legion for a wreath to be  
 placed on the cenotaph on November 11th 1960.
