Ross Municipal Council met on above date with all members present.

The minutes of former meetings were read and adopted and signed by the Reeve. Correspondence and accounts were read and discussed.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Oattes that Council re-appoint Mr. Irwin Patterson to act as Trustee to represent Ross Township on the Colden and District High School Board.

In view of the building program of S.S. No. 8 Ross it was moved by R. Oattes and seconded by H. Pilgrim that we make an advance payment on their 1960 levy of the sum of \$1,000.00.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that we accept the application of Mr. Stafford M. Millar for the work of doing the surplus snowploughing in the Township for the 1960-61 season as follows:- The rate per ^{sq} ft of the present unit to be \$7.00. A minimum of \$700.00 for the season, permission to sell and transfer this agreement to a third party (this third party to meet the approval of the Council).

Moved by George Olmstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council donate the sum of \$50.00 to the Colden and District Legion for a wreath to be placed on the cenotaph on November 11th 1960.
