Ross Municipal Council met on above date for their last regular Council meeting for 1960 with all members present.

The minutes of former meeting were read and adopted and the correspondence and accounts were read and discussed.

It was moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded Geo. Almstead that we pass a by-law to rescind former by-law No. 394 dated June 3rd 1922 whereby the Forster Telephone Association was granted the privilege of erecting telephone poles and lines on Ross Township roads necessary for telephone service at that time.

Moved by R. Oatis, seconded by Wm. Stone that we give relief to the family of John Kelly to the extent of \$40.00 per month.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council pay Forsters Falls L. O. R. No. 552 the sum of \$75.00 for the use of hall for 1960.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Reuben Oatis that Council pay Forsters Falls Public Library the usual grant of \$45.00 for the year 1960.

Moved by George Almstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council pay the Deputy Fire Chief, Mr. Allan Gilmore a salary of \$900.00 for the year 1960.

Moved by George Almstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that Council set the salaries and expenses of the Reeve and
