

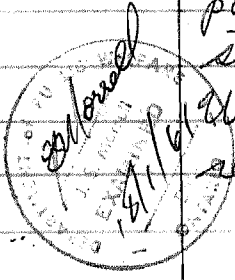
Foresters Falls, Ont. December 30th 1960

 to sign all cheques and documents for the year 1961.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead  
 that Council pass by-law No. 781 authorizing the paying  
 of all acceptable bills and accounts for the year 1961.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead  
 that we pass a by-law authorizing the Bank of Nova  
 Scotia at Colden to pay all debenture payments as they  
 become due for the year 1961.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim  
 that we subscribe for seven subscriptions to the Municipal  
 World for the year 1961.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim  
 that we engage the Colden Sun to do what Municipal  
 printing he can handle for the year 1961 in connection  
 with Council business.

Moved Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that  
 we engage William S. Byce to clean and sand the  
 streets of Forsters Falls for the year 1961.

Moved by H. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Almstead  
 that Council give a grant to School Area No 2 situated in  
 the Light Alloys, Ltd. School Area applicable to the year 1961  
 for the amount of \$7,027.80 less \$882.00 debenture payment.

Moved by R. Oattes, seconded by H. Pilgrim that Council pay the membership fee of \$15.00 to the Ontario Good Roads Association for the year 1961.
