Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council pass a by-law for the purpose of appointing Mr. Thomas W. Gill as Spraying Inspector for the year 1962 at the rate of \$1.20 per hr and that Ralph Broome be appointed as Spray Truck driver at the rate of \$1.15 per hr.

Moved by P. Catter, seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept the regular Road Appropriation ^{by-law} presented by the Department of Highways for the year 1962 for the amount of \$50,000.00 being \$20,000.00 for construction and \$30,000.00 for maintenance.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 1 for the Month of January 1962 in the amount of \$4,513.52.
