It was moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Catts that council accept the tender of Stafford M. Miller to supply the culvert and fencing requirements of the Township for the year 1962 culverts 5¢ less than list, fencing style 8-42 standard gauge at \$1.24 per rod.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council accept the tender of Smith's Construction Co. Ltd of Arnprior for crushing, hauling and spreading gravel on Township roads for the year 1962 at the following price 92¢ per ton and stockpiling at .55¢ per ton.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council increase relief payment of Hazel Harris from \$20.00 to \$25.00 per month.

Moved by Geo. Olmstead, seconded by N. Pilgrim that council approve a grant of \$100.00 to the Ross Farmers Union for the purpose of supporting this organization to a start.

Moved by G. Olmstead, seconded by N. Pilgrim that council ^{approve by paper by law to} the wages for Washie Fly Inspector at the rate of \$1.35 per hour and that a gate of 10¢ per mile be allowed Ralph Broome for use of his car in attending cattle spraying school at Ottawa. Also by-law No. 801 be rescinded

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council pay George Bennett the sum of \$300.00 for approximately 30 tons of gravel for the purpose of widening road in front of his property

Moved by N. Pilgrim, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council apply to the Department of Highways for approval to a Supplementary by-law for road construction in the amount of \$30,000.00.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that council rescind former motion calling for the taking of an option for five acres more or less on concession 6, lot S $\frac{1}{2}$ 14 owned by Duncan Murdoch and the motion now to read that we take an option on two sites in conjunction with by-law No. 803 the sites now to read as follows:-

2. Parcels of land owned by Walter Johnston, Oin Walter Victor M Loughlin

Almstead that Council introduce a by-law for the purpose of arranging a vote of the property owners of the Township of Pass for the raising by debentures the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for proposed Community Centre.
