Special meeting of council held on above date with all members present to consider tenders received for the paving of the Kerr Line road.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Olmstead that whereas only one tender was received in the specified time for the paving of the Kerr Line road and whereas this tender was not opened the council hereby agrees to consider the other tenders although they were received a little late.

The tenders were then opened and it was moved by R. Oatley and seconded by H. Pilgrim that we accept the tender of Smith's Construction Co. Ltd of Arnprior for the paving of the Kerr Line to connect with County Road No. 7 + 9 approximately 5.5 miles at a price of \$4,567.50 it being the lowest tender.
