

Forrestus Falls, Ont. September 5th 1962

Ross Municipal Council met in their regular monthly meeting on above date with all members present.

Correspondence and accounts were read and considered.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by George Olmstead that the Council become the purchasers of all properties subject to land tax sale which have not been sold at the tax sale for an amount at least equal to the amount of taxes due against said properties.

Moved by George Olmstead seconded by Wm. Stone that council accept and pay Road Voucher No. 8 for the month of August 1962 in the amount of \$7,474.92.
