

Foresters Falls, Ont. February 18th 1963

A special meeting of Pass council was called on above date to consider the proposed change over of hydro in Foresters Falls and the townships of Light Alloys, Ltd + Dominion Magnesium and installing street lights at Halcy + Millars corner, the purchase of a township truck and consideration of Road Appropriation by-law.

It was moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by Wm. Stone that council authorize Ontario Hydro to replace existing 21 radial wave lights with 21 - 250 Watt mercury vapour luminaires mounted on six-foot arms at an annual mill rate of 3.5 mills on F. Falls village assessment.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by Geo. Almstead that council negotiate the necessary agreement to install street lights at Millars Corner, Halcy, Ltd. Industries and Village of Halcy. Agreement to involve ratepayers, Dept. of Highways, Halcy Industries and Ontario Hydro.

Annual mill rate for upkeep of lights to be 3.5 mills on the assessment involved.

Moved by Geo. Almstead, seconded by H. Pilgrim that council rescind former motion calling for tenders for a three or four ton truck and that we now call tenders for a three ton truck.

Moved by Wm. Stone, seconded by R. Patten that council pass a by-law for the purpose of accepting Road Appropriation by-law No. 819 in the amount of \$52,000.00 for the year 1963 an amount of \$20,000.00 for construction and \$32,000.00 for maintenance.
